Week 6 – Big Blocks

Note: If working with fat quarters, make sure to cut as frugally as possible. Also, save excess strips for later weeks.

Cutting:

Lap & Queen:

Background	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· Cut (1) strip 4 ½" x WOF ↳ subcut (8) 4 ½" squares
C	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· Cut (2) 4 ½" squares
D	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· Cut (2) 4 ½" squares
E	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· Cut (4) 4 ½" squares
H	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· Cut (2) 4 ½" squares
I	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· Cut (2) 4 ½" squares
J	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· Cut (4) 4 ½" squares
K	<p>Note: cut as many pieces as you can from previous strips before cutting new strips.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">· For old style folded corners: Cut (1) 1 ½" strip x WOF ↳ subcut (24) 1 ½" squares· <u>OR</u> For folded corners with trim up: Cut (1) 2 ¼" strip x WOF ↳ subcut (12) 2 ¼" squares, then cut in half on the diagonal ☒

Assemble 8 quarter star blocks, should measure 12 ½" square.

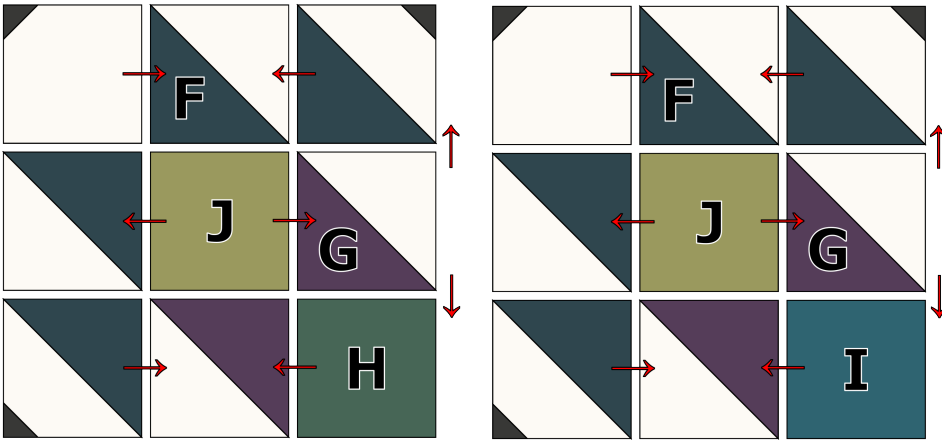
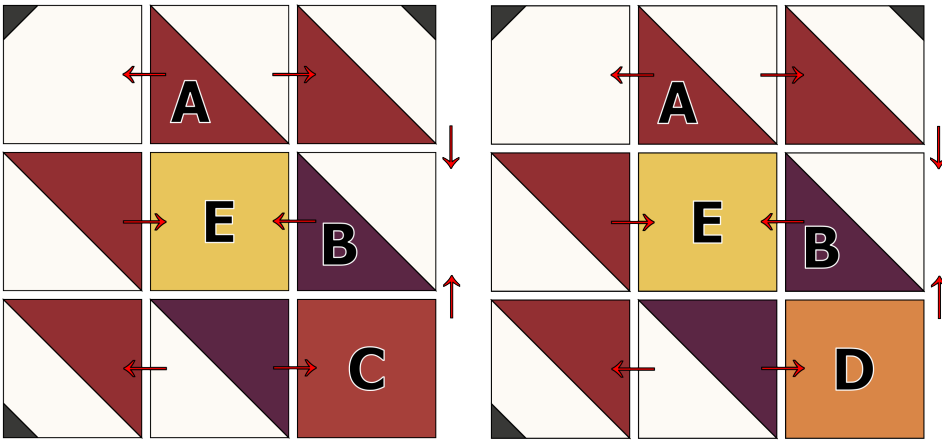
Add folded corners to 3 corners of each block.

Queen only:

Background	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· Cut (3) strips 3 ½" x WOF & use leftover 3 ½" strip from week 3 ↳ subcut (44) 3 ½" squares
D	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· Cut (11) 3 ½" squares
E	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· Cut (11) 3 ½" squares
H	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· Cut (11) 3 ½" squares
J	<ul style="list-style-type: none">· Cut (11) 3 ½" squares

Assemble 22 half star blocks, should measure 6 ½" x 12 ½".

Lap & Queen: make 2 of each



Queen only: make 11 of each
